#### **021/26 County Councillors Report**

Cllr Batters reported on the following issues:

The Parish Council would like to record its grateful thanks to Cllr R Tyers for the considerable time and effort he has put into this project to ensure a successful outcome.

**027/26 To Consider any further information received regarding the updating of the Littledowns defibrillator**

The Chairman had contacted Duchy Defibrillators. They agreed that the Parish Council could purchase a battery separately and fit it and still be covered by the insurance. Cllr L Sutton proposed and Cllr K Rowe seconded to purchase the battery. All agreed. Cllr G Tucker proposed and Cllr D Saunter seconded that the clerk could pay the invoice once Cllr Tyers has obtained it. All in favour. The Chairman will inform Duchy Defibrillators of what we will be doing. The Parish Council thanked Cllr R Tyers for agreeing to source the battery.
